Yalta traditions in professional swimming were born already since 1960-s. Antonina Rudenko, who became the champion of Europe in 1966, was born and trained in Yalta.

Since 1990 the 50-meters long swimming pool in the Hotel "Yalta" has become the place, where the Ukrainian swimmers were trained. Since 2009 after the reconstruction, this swimming pool is known as one of the best open swimming pools in our country, which can be used both with sea- and sweet water. In 2009 in Yalta for the first time was held the national All-Ukrainian Cup in swimming on the open water. The swimmers from the Ukraine, Russia and Byelorussia took part in this competition. A year later the same competition took place on the embankment of Yalta and was even more successful.

This fall Yalta has got the right to organize European Masters Championship in water sports. We believe, that these competitions will become "an incitement" for the development of aquatic sports in our city. More than three thousands of athletes will come to our place, and they will demonstrate, that water sports are not only very useful, but also very interesting and attractive occupation.

About Ukraine








Ukraine. Its area of 603,628 km² makes it roughly as large as Metropolitan France and slightly smaller than Texas. While some claim that "Ukraine is the largest country in Europe", this view is not generally supported by sources outside the country. Ukraine borders Russian Federation to the east and northeast, Belarus to the northwest, Poland, Slovakia and Hungary to the west, Romania and Moldova to the southwest, and the Black Sea and Sea of Azov to the south and southeast respectively.

Ukraine is a unitary state composed of 24 oblasts (provinces), one autonomous republic (Crimea), and two cities with special status: Kiev, its capital and largest city, and Sevastopol. Ukraine is a republic under a semi-presidential system with separate legislative, executive, and judicial branches. Since the collapse of the USSR, Ukraine continues to maintain the second largest military in Europe, after Russia. The country is home to 46 million people, 77.8% of whom are ethnic Ukrainians, with sizable minorities of Russians (17%), Belarusians and Romanians. The Ukrainian language is the only official language in Ukraine. Russian is also widely spoken. The dominant religion in the country is Eastern Orthodox Christianity, which has heavily influenced Ukrainian architecture, literature and music.

Ukraine's capital is Kiev, has a rich history dating back more than 1500 years. With a population near 3 million and founded in 482 AD, Kiev is situated on hills overlooking the famous Dnieper River.



Livadia palace

Excursion to Livadia palace is a visit of palace of Nickolas II, a view of romantic castle the Swallow's nest from a specific view-point. During a few decades Livadia was the favorite rest place of the Romanovs' imperial family. In 1945 the historical meeting of the Heads of three powers: Stalin, Roosevelt and Churchill took place at the majestic tsar's palace due to which the fate of the post-war world was decided and Livadia got its world fame.



Tour to Vorontsov palace in Alupka

A palace of the governor-general of Novorossiya, count M. S. Vorontsov, built in the first half of XIX in style of late English gothic architecture with the elements of the East, due to an original architectural decision and unique planning got glory of architectural masterpiece. The interiors of the palace acquaint the visitors with the way of life of noble family of middle of the XIX century. And round the palace there is a luxurious Alupka park, a unique example of landscapegardening, delighting by the spacious glades, cascades of waterfalls and smooth surface of ponds.



Tour to Sevastopol

Sevastopol is а citv of monuments, obelisks museums. It's heroic past is told by famous Panorama museum "Defense of Sevastopol in 1854-1855 ", Diorama "Assault of Sapun mountain in May, 7, 1944", Marine boulevard, Count's landing stage. And earlier history continues to live in the walls of Chersonesus saving the ancient and medieval monuments of Crimea. Chersonesus is a sacred place for orthodox Christians: here the Great prince Vladimir the Kievan was baptized in 988.



Getting out to Massandra palace of Alexander III

History of Massandra palace is enigmatic and surprising. It was built for Alexander III at the end of 19th century in style of the French castles of times of Lui XIII. During the years of Soviet power the palace was used long time as state dacha and it was inaccessible for visitors up to 1992 when a museum was opened in it.



Swallow's Nest, cape Ai Todor

IFamous "The Swallow's nest", a symbol of the South coast and all Crimea, is a miniature castle covered by romanticism, placed by some miracle above the sea at the edge of the large Aurora rock.

It is a card of Crimea, built in 1912 - a place of pilgrimage of tourists from all over the world.






Yalta 2011 Kiev







Kiev is known as a green city with two botanical gardens and numerous large and small parks. The green nature of the city is probably most notable by the green hills of the right bank along the Dnieper river that have been relatively untouched by development.

Founders of Kiev

The centre of Kiev (Independence Square and Khreschatyk Street) becomes a large outdoor party place at night during summer months, with thousands of people having a good time in nearby restaurants, clubs and outdoor cafes.

The central streets are closed for auto traffic on weekends and holidays. Andriyivskyy Descent is one of the best known historic streets and a major tourist attraction in Kiev. The hill is the site of the Castle of Richard the Lionheart; the baroque-style St. Andrew's Church; the home of Kiev born writer, Mikhail Bulgakov; the monument to Yaroslav the Wise, the Grand Prince of Kiev and of Novgorod; and numerous other monuments.


At the city's southern outskirts, near the historic Pyrohiv village, there is an outdoor museum, officially called the Museum of Folk Architecture and Life of Ukraine It has an area of 1.5 square kilometres. This territory houses several "mini-villages" that represent by region the traditional rural architecture of Ukraine.

St. Sophia's Cathedral takes a leading place among all monuments and sights in Kiev.

The Cathedral was planned as the main temple of the Kievan Rus and was erected in the center of old Kiev at the first half of XI cent. Initially the Cathedral was built in Byzantine style, had pyramidal structure with 13 domes.

After the reconstruction in 1688 the Cathedral got its baroque view. In the XVII cent. St. Sophia houses male monastery (till 1786) and was the residence of Kievan metropolitans.

The Golden Gate, the rest of a huge wall that was erected in the 10th century to protect the city; and see the Parliament building that is situated in a beautiful park.

HOW TO REACH US



KIEV, YALTA - by air

The main air gate to Ukraine is Kiev International Airport (KBP).

There are about 10 daily flights from Kiev to Simferopol International Airport (SIP), which is the nearest to Yalta.

Several airlines perform direct flights from Europe to Simferopol Airport as well.

Simferopol Airport is located 85 km (1,5 hour drive) far from Yalta.

Transporation from Simferopol Airport or from Simferopol Train Station can be provided on demand.

You will find Welcome Desks at the official Airports (KBP&SIP) and Simferopol Train Station as well.

The Universal International Agency has been selected to manage airline and accommodation service for the European Masters Championships 2011 in Yalta/Kiev. Book your flight tickets through Universal International Agency web site *www.aviabest.com* and you will get special discount for Austrian, Lufthansa, Turkish, Ukrainian International Airlines and Aerosvit flight companies.

YALTA by car

The main road route into Yalta from west boarder, although there is also good access on the E-40, E-50, To E-97, E- 105. Main point to entrance from Balkan countries, Hungary, Romania, Slovakia, Czech Republic - Chop, Chernivci.

From Germany, Poland - Lviv (Mosticka, Dorohusk), Lutsk (Rava Ruska, Yagotyn).

From Baltic republic, Belorussia, Russia - north boarder end further via Kiev, Kharkov to south direction Crimea (E-95).

YALTA by train

By train: The national Ukrainian Railways Network offers a full range of services interconnecting the major cities of Europe (Berlin, Prague, Budapest, Vienna, Warsaw, Roma, Belgrade, Sofia, and others) through Lvov and Kiev to Simferopol (*www.uz.gov.ua*).



The competition will take place in Black Sea on the beach area Yalta Intourist Hotel.

The competition will start at 10:00 in waves with 15 minutes interval. The start and finish are situated in the same place.

Events

Competitors will be seeded in waves according to age groups from youngest to the oldest to assure similar wind and water conditions. Competitors may be selected irrespective of gender.

In each wave, the Referee may order out any competitors who have not finished the race within forty five (45) minutes after the arrival of the winner in the same wave and age group.

shall apply:

MA-G GENERAL

MA-G 1 Event and Organisation

MA-G 1.1 The Championships shall be conducted in Swimming, Diving, Open Water Swimming and Synchronised Swimming.

MA-G 1.2 The Championships shall be held every odd year.

MA-G 1.3 The organising Federation and the place where the Championships shall be held will be decided by the LEN Bureau and circulated by the LEN Office.

MA-G 1.4 The LEN Bureau Delegate and the LEN Masters Committee (LEN MaC) shall be responsible for and supervise the organisation of the event and the correct conduct of the competitions according to LEN Rules and Regulations.

They shall decide on all matters arising on site at the competitions which require an immediate decision.

MA-G 2 Entries and Entry Fees

MA-G 2.1 Competitors shall be eligible for a club either affiliated to a Member Federation or affiliated to a Federation registered by LEN.

MA-G 2.2 Entries shall be confirmed and submitted by the Federation in the name of the club to which the competitor belongs.

MA-G 2.3 Any competitor having represented a non-European Club shall not represent an European club unless he has been under the jurisdiction of one or several European clubs for at least twelve (12) months.

MA-G 2.4 Entries, including signed Release of Liability by every competitor, shall be sent to the Organising Committee together with one photo (passport size).

MA-G 2.5 The deadline for the submission of entries and the payment of the entry fees shall be no later than the date announced by the LEN Office.

MA-G 2.6 Entry fees shall be as decided by the LEN Bureau and circulated by the Organising Committee.

MA-G 2.7 Entry fees shall be paid to the Organising Committee. Confirmation of payment shall be attached to the entries.

MA-G 2.8 There shall be no refund of entry fees.

MA-G 3 Accreditation

MA-G 3.1 Accreditation shall be issued free of charge for:

a. all competitors and approved officials of the <?>Federations;

b. any President of a Member Federation or a Federation registered by LEN;

c. all persons nominated by LEN;

d. all persons involved in the organisation of the Championships.

No other person shall receive an accreditation.

MA-G 3.2 Each Competitor may collect his/her Accreditation Card with a photo two (2) days prior to the Championships at the Accreditation Centre after proof of identity (passport or ID card).

MA-G 3.3 The Organising Committee shall check name, age and entries before handing out the accreditation card.

MA-G 4 Awards

MA-G 4.1 Victory Ceremonies shall take place after each event at a place and a time announced by the Organising Committee.

Medals shall be awarded to competitors placed first to third in each event and age group.

Diplomas shall be awarded to competitors placed first to eighth in each event and age group.

MA-G 4.2 Points shall not be counted and no awards shall be given to Federations or clubs.

MA-G 4.3 A commemorative souvenir shall be given to each competitor starting and to each approved official.

MA-G 5 Officials

MA-G 5.1 The LEN MaC shall nominate for each competition session one (1) Technical Delegate and one (1) Referee.

MA-G 5.2 Federations may nominate suitably qualified and experienced officials for each aquatic discipline.

MA-G 5.2.1 Applications shall be submitted to the LEN Office no later than the date announced by the LEN Office.

MA-G 5.2.2 Officials approved are on the costs of the nominating Federation.

MA-G 5.3 The Technical Delegate shall nominate







the key officials to be on duty on each competition session.

MA-G 5.4 The organising Federation shall provide all the other officials.

100-119, 120-159, 160-199, 200-239, 240-279,

280-319, 320-359 (and forty year increments as high as is necessary).

All members of a relay team must be from the same club and have completed the individual entry form.

The total age of the team members (determined by the year of birth) determines the age group of the team.

A competitor may only compete in one age group in the same relay event.

MA-SW 1.4 Competitors may be entered for a maximum of five individual events, but not for more than two individual events each day.

MA-SW 1.5 The order of the events and the Entry Times shall be decided by the LEN Executive on proposal of the LEN MaC and the LEN Bureau Liaison.

MA-SW 2 Confirmation of participation and composition of Relay Teams

MA-SW 2.1 Competitors participating in 400 m and 800 m races shall confirm their participation to the Organising Committee no later than six o'clock p.m. (18.00 hrs) on the day prior to the event.

MA-SW 2.2 Clubs participating in Relay Events shall confirm their participation and submit the names of the competitors and the order of swimming no later than six o'clock p.m. (18.00 hrs) on the day prior to the event.

Reserve swimmers are not allowed.

MA-SW 3 Lane seeding, start and ordering out of the competition

MA-SW 3.1 Competitors will be seeded according to the submitted entry times, beginning with the oldest age group first and within an age group the slower heats first.

MA-SW 3.2 In 400 m and 800 m races two competitors will be deck seeded and swimming in one lane.

The seeding shall be by time only and not by agegroup.

MA-SW 3.3 Overhead start will be used in all events.

MA-SW 3.4 Each competitor is responsible to report to the clerk of course at least 15 minutes prior to the designated race at the marshalling area at the pool.

MA-SW 3.5 In individual events of more than 200 m the Referee may order out any competitor who passed the entry time for the relevant age group.

MA-SW 4 Classification

MA-SW 4.1 Individual swimmers will be listed in the result list with name, name of the club, official country code and split times according to ranking and age group.

MA-SW 4.2 Relay teams will be listed in the result list with the name of the club and official country code according to ranking and age group, including names of swimmers and individual split times.

MA-SW 4.3 Any competitor not starting, disqualified, or not finishing the race within the required entry time will be placed at the end of the result list without ranking and time.

The reason shall be mentioned.

MA-SW 4.4 A competitor who has a permanent disability shall not be disqualified in a case where his disability prevents him/her from complying with the rules of a particular stroke, provided that the







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disability has been notified

to the referee by the competitor or his/her representative before the race takes place. Notification shall be a medical certificate issued by the Medical Officer of the Federation.

MA-SS 3 Competitions

MA-SS 3.1 The Technical Routine shall be performed according to the FINA required elements for Masters Technical Routines (Appendix I to FINA Masters Synchronised Swimming Rules). Technical Routines have to include all required elements. Music selection is optional and may be the same music as used in the Free Routine.

MA-SS 3.2 There are no restrictions for Free Routines neither in regard to choice of music nor in regard to content of choreography.

MA-SS 3.3 Scoring will be calculated as in FINA Rule SS 19.1. In Duets and Teams the competitors' Technical Routine scores will be added and the total divided by the number of competitors for a final Technical Routine Scores.

MA-SS 3.4 The order of events shall be decided by the Bureau Executive after consultation of the MaC and the Bureau Liaison to this Committee. MA-SS 3.5 The order of appearance for Technical Routines and Free Routines shall be decided by draw for each event in each age group. The age group to start is pulled, and the age groups are drawn by lot. The draw shall take place at the Technical Meeting to be held no later than twenty-four (24) hours before the beginning of the first part of the competition and shall be conducted in public under the direction of the Technical Delegates.

MA-SS 3.6 The order of appearance for each event and each age group shall be decided by draw. The draw shall take place at the Technical Meeting to be held no later than twenty-four (24) hours before the beginning of the first part of the competition and shall be conducted in public under the direction of the Technical Delegates.

MA-SS 4 Time Limits

MA-SS 4.1 Time limits for the Technical and Free Routines for Solo, Duet, Teams, and for Free Combinations shall be in accordance with FINA Masters Synchronised Swimming Rules.

MA-SS 5 Confirmation of participation and composition of duet and team events

MA-SS 5.1 Competitors participating in Duet and Team events shall confirm their participation to the

Organising Committee no later than six p.m. (18.00 hrs) on the day prior to the event.

MA-SS 5.2 Reserve swimmers may be substituted up to two hours prior to the start of the first routine of the relevant event


